Teddies in a Blanket

Ingredients:

- + 1 pkt Mini teddy biscuits (Bi-lo have a home band of these)
- + 1 pkt plain square biscuits
- + 1 pkt ready made icing
- + Small jar of strawberry jam

* Optional small iced flowers or tubes of icing mixture for decorations.

To make: (steps one and two could be made by Leader or parent help as Mob meeting commences).

1. Prepare ready made icing according to the directions; roll out to thickness about 3mm.
2. Cut icing into 45 thick strips (6cm x 2.5 cm), and 45 thin strips (6cm x 1 cm).
3. Joey Scouts place the plain biscuits down and dab a little jam on the back of the mini teddies.
4. Joey Scout place two mini teddies side by side on the plain biscuits with their head up toward the top of the biscuit.
5. Joey Scout smear small amount of jam on one side of the thick strip of icing and place this, jam side down over the teddies, just under the head of the teddies.
6. Joey Scouts then place the thin strip of icing on the top edge of the thick piece again just under the head of the teddies. (This is the fold down of the blanket.)
7. Joey Scout decorate the blankets with sprinkles/flowers or icing as desired (optional)

* Teddies in the blanket can be placed in airtight containers if not eaten on the night.
