Grassy heads make great gifts. You can grow a head with long hair or trim it into fancy hair cuts.

Need: Per Joey Scout

Cut off foot of a old stocking

Scissors

Grass Seed

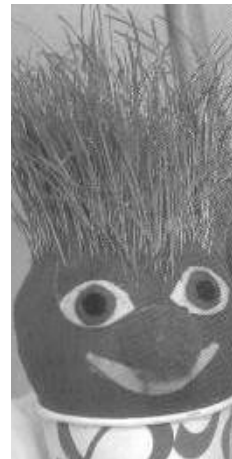
Potting mix

Rubber band

Stick on eyes or felt pieces

Felt for mouth

Paper cup



To Make:

- Put a generous handful of grass seeds in the end of the toe and press it down in a thick layer.
- Fill up the toe with potting mix, press down each handful firmly, continue until you have a good size head.
- Knot the end.
- Make a nose by pulling out a small nodule in the middle of the face area and fix an elastic band around the bottom on the nodule.
- Cut out mouth and stick on eyes.
- Sit on the cup, take home and water the next day after the glue dries.
