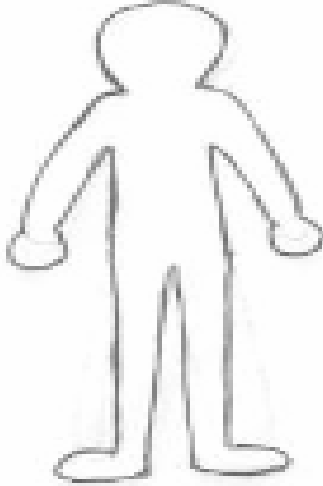

Dolly Dazzlers

You'll Need:

Broder cotton in assorted colours of your choice.
Thick cardboard, that's firm enough to make the dolls body.
Hairclip backs (these are also called 'barrette' backs) or brooch clips or safety pins.
Scissors.

What to Do:

1. Using the figure on the left draw the simple figure of a doll on firm cardboard. Cut out the figure.
2. Make small snips at the top of the head, each wrist and ankle; the slits will hold thread ends in place.
3. Wrap your choice of coloured thread around the doll's head, arms, shoulders, torso and legs. When changing colours glue the ends to the cardboard.
4. To turn legs into a long skirt simply wrap threads around both legs at once.
5. To make hair (you can use embroidery wool) plait or loop small lengths of thread together. Clue to head.
6. To convert your doll into a useful work of art, glue a clip or safety pin to the back
