Need: per Joey Scout

- ❖ Shells of six eggs,
- ❖ 1tsp hot water from tap,
- ❖ 1tsp flour
- ❖ Sheet of paper towel

Wash egg shells thoroughly. Dry shells and grind them
(you can use a rock or similar object. Grind until you have a powder).

To Make:

Mix flour with hot water to make a paste, add one level dessert spoon of egg powder, mix well.

Shape the mixture into a stick form (roughly size of stick of chalk, roll a strip of paper towel around the stick.

Set aside for at least three days to dry.

When dry peel back the paper towel and use.

Note for Leaders: You could ask all your Parents to save their egg shells at the beging of term.
