Easter Lilies for Mum

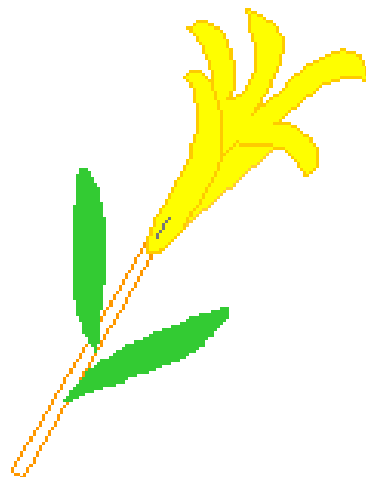

These lilies are made from the Joey Scouts handprint (on paper), stapled to a straw. You can make an entire bouquet of flowers for a great gift for Mothers Day.

Equipment needed: Construction paper, Pencil, Scissors, Green pipe cleaners (or straws), Tape or glue Stapler

To make:

- Trace the Joey Scouts hand onto construction paper, then cut the handprint out.
- Curl each of the fingers around a pencil.
- Use the palm of the handprint to form a cone (with the fingers curling outwards). Glue or tape the cone together.
- Staple the flower to a pipe cleaner or a drinking straw.
- Draw some leaves on green construction paper and cut them out.
- Staple or tape the leaves to the straw.
- Make a few of these flowers for a beautiful bouquet.
