Pick up Monkeys

You'll Need:

Scissors, 10 bumpy pipe cleaners in different colours, craft glue, 20 small-medium pompoms, 20 very small pompoms, 20 googly eyes.

What to do:

1. Cut bumpy pipe cleaners in half, making sure that each piece has two bumps.
2. To make the arms and legs, bend each pipe cleaner in half. Place two halves together and secure at the bend with craft glue.
3. To make the bodies and heads, glue two small-medium pompoms together, then glue where the arms and legs join.
4. For the faces, glue on the googly eyes, then glue two very small pompoms onto the top of one of the small-medium pompoms for ears.
5. Bend monkeys' arms and legs into shape to form hands and feet, and to make them easy to pick up.

How to Play:

Put Monkeys on the floor. Take it in turns to hook one monkey onto another monkey and so on. The winner is the one who picks up the most Monkeys.
