Safety Pin Bracelet

Need: (depending on the size of your Mob you may need to increase the beads x2)

- 1 Packet round seed beads
- 1 Packet long beads
- 1 Packet large round beads

Medium- sized silver or gold safety pins

Hat elastic
Clear- drying glue

To Make:

- Measure around the Joeys Wrist with elastic and, allowing about 4 cm extra for tying off, cut 2 pieces that length.
- Open a safety pin and thread beads onto the pin side leaving enough space to close the pin. Alternate the bead pattern with each pin. Eg: for one pin thread 3 blue beads, 1 long bead, then 2 blue. For the other, thread 2 blue beads, 1 long bead, then 3 blue. Close pin to ensure beads don't fall off.
- When all pins are beaded, glue pinheads with clear-drying glue.
- Tie double knots at one end of each elastic about 2 cm from ends.
- Thread elastics through the top and bottom holes in the pins. Alternate 1 pinhead up, 1 pinhead down. Place a large coloured bead in between each safety pin (top and bottom) as you go.
- Allow about 2 cm at the end of each piece of elastic and tie each end together.
