Feeding Santa Box

Equipment:

- Medium size box or a shoe box
- White paper to wrap the box
- Black felt marker
- 2 x large googly eyes
- Scissors
- Red Poster paint
- Cotton wool
- White Pompom
- Several Ping pong balls or you could use something like marshmallows



To Make:

1. Cover the box in white paper
2. On one side draw a large oval shaped face, draw a large "O" shaped mouth and a Santa hat on the oval.
3. Stick the Googly eyes on and draw around them with the marker.
4. Paint the hat red and glue the Pompom on the end of the hat.

To Play:

- Place the Santa box on a flat surface. The Joey Scouts try to get the most of the ping pong balls into Santa mouth.

Note:

I have used this as a Joey / Parent game. We used marshmallows instead of balls. They ate the marshmallows after.

You could have a few boxes made and play the game in teams.
