



Hunter & Coastal Cub-O-ree 2008

Application Policy

Information for: District Cub Leaders, Regional Office and Cub leaders.

Eligibility

Cubs: All registered Cubs and new Cubs can apply up to the 1st August with the discretion of their Cub leaders, preferably to have had one over night away with their pack.

If a Cub applies from outside of the Region they must be accompanied by Leaders and Approval from the RC-CS H&C.

Leaders: Must be a Leader or leader in training within the Region with a “cleared” status. If outside of Region then they have to be a COAL Leader.

Adult helpers: Have prior work with their Pack and have attended at least one camp. All parents attending to have assigned role and made ware of scouting policies and provide a signed PED form. District Activities coordinators or District Camp Coordinator will assign task areas.

Scouts: Scouts can attend at the discretion of the DCSL and can only work on their District Activity base.
If a Scout is attending the camp as part of their service then the Scouts must gain the approval from their Scout Leader or the RCS, for the service to be accredited. A PED form needs to be signed by all Scouts attending.

Joeys: Joeys can't attend

All applicants must have Membership number on their application.
(Scouts please pay attention to requirement for service recognition)

Cost:

Cub Scouts: \$75 Leaders, Parent Helpers, Scout Helpers and Venture Helpers: \$40.
Each District is allowed 6 cooks at \$25 each due to the cooks not participating in the activities.

The only exception to payment will be the RC, SC /ASC and those performing logistic role as well as special presenters arranged for the Cuboree. There will be NO Visitors rates or day rates. Each District has been allowed to invite their DC to the camp at no cost. If the DC is assisting with their district or performing another role at Cub-O-Ree.

Applications:

All applications are to be forward to the Regional Office by the 16th May for processing of the first payment. The second payment is due by 25th July. A provision for Cubs changing their minds or new members to the pack, their application will be accepted up to the 1st August 2008.

Please forward your application and money to your Cub Scout Leaders who will then arrange a Group cheque and forward it with the Pack applications to Scouts Australia, Hunter and Coastal Region, PO Box 854 The Junction 2291.

Closing Date for Applications at the Region Office:

First payment: Cub Scouts \$30 by 16th May 2008.
Leader, Scouts Parents, Ventures etc a \$20 by 16th May 2008.

Second Payment: Cub Scouts \$45 by 25th July 2008.
Leader, Scouts Parents, Ventures etc a \$20 by 25th July 2008.

Refund:

A full refund is available up to 22nd August 2008

A \$10 administration fee will apply to all refunds between 21st July and 29th August 2008

No refund will be issued after 1st September 2008 (packs can do an in house swap up to 5th September).
