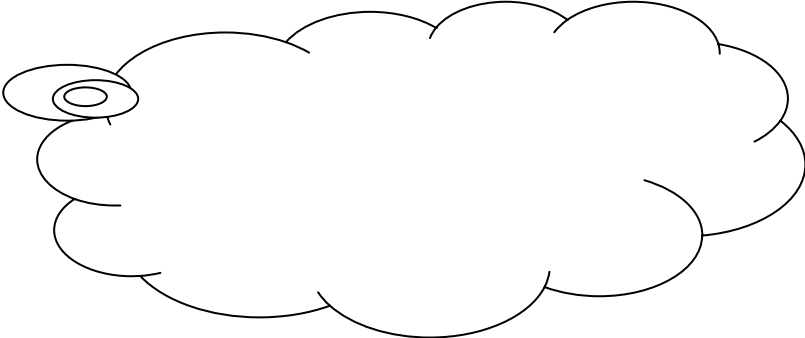

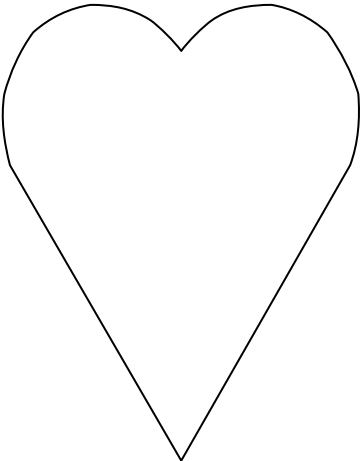

<b>General Comments</b>
<p><b>Coming in Activity-Rainbow Bubbles</b>  <b>Equipment:</b> Small containers (yogurt pots will do) with detergent and water mixed. Pipe cleaners bent into a ring and handle.  <b>Method:</b>            Meet the Joey Scouts outside and blow bubbles. Ask the Joey Scouts to specially look for the rainbow colours in the bubbles.</p> <p><b>Note:</b>            This night could be a good night to commence a Joey Scout Mob Payer Book. Give the book each week to a different Joey Scout. Ask the Joey Scout to write a prayer in the book, encourage them to decorate the page. Tell both the Joey Scouts and Parents that the Joey Scouts can have help from parent for their payer, it maybe be one from a book or one made up, the parent may write the pray if the Joey Scout wishes. When the Joey Scout brings the book back the following week ask them would they like to read out their prayer or like you the leader to read it at closing parade.</p>

## **Game – The Flood**

**Equipment:** Nil

Designate the four walls of the hall as ANIMALS, BIRDS, FISH and PEOPLE and the centre of the hall as THE ARK. On the call BIRDS the Joeys “fly” to the BIRD wall. On the call FISH the Joeys “swim” to the FISH wall, ANIMALS they crawl on all fours and PEOPLE they run. On the call FLOOD they all run to the ark.

## **Activity – Create a picture prayer**

**Equipment:** A4 sheet of paper per Joey Scout, magazines/newspapers, glue, scissors. Joey Scouts cut out pictures from magazines that represent things they are thankful for and glue them onto an A4 sheet of paper this then becomes their picture prayer.

\* Option: The Joey Scouts may like to share with the Mob and explain their prayer.

## **Game – Noah’s Ark**

**Equipment:** cards with Pictures animals and birds (2 of each).

Give each Joey a card (make sure you give out two of each of the same animal or bird) Without telling anyone or showing the card to anyone the Joey Scouts have to find their partner (can make animal or bird noises, or ask are you a .....? With the other response being a yes or no answer only)

Variation: Each Joey is given a different card. The Joey Scouts must, one at a time, act out the animal or Bird that they are and the other Joeys, sitting in a circle try to guess what he/she is.

## **Activity – Caring Tree**

**Equipment:** A large piece of cardboard or paper and Texta’s, Blu Tac.

Draw a large bare branched tree. Draw big heart shaped leaves on it. Encourage the Joey Scouts to share some of the caring deeds they have performed during the week (or what they intend to do during the next week). The Leader writes the deeds on the leaves and asks the Joey Scouts to place the leaf on the tree with a little blu tac.

The following verse can be written in the trunk of the tree:

Like the strong trees that I see,  
Help me God to always be,  
One who CARES and SHARES each day,  
To DO MY BEST in every way,  
And HELP OTHER PEOPLE.

## **Craft: Cloud Mobile**

**Equipment:** Coat hangers, four or five cloud cut outs per Joey Scout, cotton/wool or fine string

Ask your Joeys to tell you something that they think would make God happy. Then ask them if they think these same things would make them happy too.

Write the ideas on card clouds and make a mobile. Some will have trouble writing, get them to tie the string to the clouds or cut the clouds out while others do the writing.

Tie the Clouds to the Coat Hangers to make their mobiles.

## **Game- Animal Salad**

Joey Scouts in pairs. Each pair is given the name of an animal. Sit them in teams with their partner opposite, legs out stretched and feet touching. You need a space between each pair so players can step between each set of legs.

When a leader calls their animal name, the pair jump up, run up the inside of teams, stepping over the legs, round the back of the team and up the inside again to their place and sit down. Call next animal, and so on.

## **Game- Bring Out Your Best**

### **Equipment:** Nil

You might like to tell the Joey Scouts that our God wants us to care for others, during this game we will SHOW THAT CARE BY SAYING SOMETHING NICE ABOUT THE PERSON NEXT TO US. The Joey Scouts make up some thing starting with the first initial of the person on there left.

This is a good self-esteem activity.

Joeys and Leaders stand in a circle. Start with a leader who says to the person on the left, "Tim is tall", and then sits down. Tim says to the next person, "Adam is amazing" then sits down. When the whole circle is sitting, go around one more time with another compliment, this time not necessarily one that starts with the person's name. Stand up when you've said your compliment.
