General Comments
<p>Coming in activity: Help sally find the Joey Scouts.</p> <p>Joey Scout Hop- This Hop is a ceremonial Hop Place Paws up. Jump once up on the spot, saying “Help” as you jump Jump one step forward, saying “Other” as you jump Jump back to original spot, saying “People” as you jump</p>

Game- Joey In the Mud

Equipment: Nil

One Joey Scout is chosen as "it". On command go all the Joey Scouts run around the hall. "It" chases and tips the Joey Scouts, once tipped, the Joey Scouts are frozen until another Joey Scout touches them to release them.

Game – Tunnel Ball

Equipment: balls (soccer or basketball)

Divide the Joey Scouts into two teams; (one for small Mob)

Three variations – rolling the ball between the legs, Over- head passing the ball backwards
Hand passing one under, one over.

Craft – Make a Good Deed week Calender

Equipment: A4 sheet of cardboard per Joey Scout, Glue ,Scissors, Pencils or Texta's , Small piece of wool. Stapler

To make: Copy the Good Deed Calender stencil, One page per Joey Scout. Give each JS an A4 size sheet of cardboard, allow the JS to draw/decorate/paste pictures to the cardboard. Cut the four-week calendar and staple the four sheets one behind the other and then staple them to the cardboard. Punch two holes on the top of the cardboard and thread the wool through to enable it to hang. Ask the Joey Scouts to keep a record over then next four weeks, each day they can tick the things they have done.

Game – Joey Scout HOP

Equipment: Nil

Divide the Joey Scouts into two teams. Each team forms a line with members one behind the other, squatting, at one end of the hall. The first Joey Scout in each team folds their arms and the others place their hand on the hips of the person in front. The team then has to jump forward collectively without the players losing their balance, to get to the other end of the hall.

Game – Joey Scout Balloon Balance

Place the Joey Scout into pairs, each pair place a balloon between their hips. On the command "go" the pair run to the end of hall and back to the start, keeping the balloon between their hips. If the pairs drop their balloon they must stop and pick them up and reposition them between their hips.

Game – Cross the Circle

Equipment: Nil

The Joey Scouts form a circle, and get on their hand and knees, facing inwards. Number the Joey Scouts alternately 1-2, 1-2.

As each number is called, the Joey Scouts with that number moves one limb forward. The aim of the game is for everyone to cross the circle. Will need lots of co-operation.

Activity- Form H.O.P

Challenge the Joey Scouts to form letters using their bodies. The children work in twos and threes to form the letters HOP. The letters can be formed standing up or lying down. They may like to try to spell other words using body letters.

Variations: Leader call one of the letters at a time, the whole Mob form that letter.

Hide and Seek

The Joey Scouts are playing hide and seek in the park. Sally is "IT" - she has to try and find the others. Can you help Sally find them? Look carefully - they've found some good hiding places.
