<u>General Comments</u>

BALLOON CREATURES

You can buy the long thin balloon for making the creatures and they come with instructions usually. Several balloon pumps are very useful (get your parents doing this one).

FACE PAINTING

A red nose and smiling mouth, white background, green or blue crosses for eyes. The Region has a face painting kit, you can book it for a small fee (to cover replacements).

TIGHT ROPE WALKING

A plank across two milk crates works and is easy. On a sleep-over once a cub leader tied the tow line of his four wheel drive to a tree and we tied a rope above it (parallel to it) and the Joeys held onto the rope while sliding along the tow wire.

JUGGLING BALLS

You put a small ball size amount of rice in a sandwich bag and tie it in a knot. Then cut the ends off of two balloons leaving only the circle part. Push the plastic bag of rice into one of the balloons, it will leave a little plastic showing put a second balloon over the exposed end. Each Joey Scout can make three to have a go at juggling with.

SIMON SAYS (MIME)

Simon says without saying a word. What ever the leader does the rest must mimic, change leader regularly.

PLATE TWIRLING

Each Joey Scout gets a 30 cm piece of dowel and an aluminium plate. The idea is to balance the plate on the end of the dowel.
