Coming in activity: Make Scarves and Goggles.

Note: There is also a flying award attached which may be filled out and given out on closing parade.

Options: Leaders could be dressed as pilots and could take on names eg: Kingsford Smith, Wright, Amelia etc

You could also decorate the hall to look like a plane hangar, or a secret training facility.

Birthdays:

Next week: Father's Day. Remind JS to bring their Dad, uncle or granddad if possible.

Notes: Flight awards can be given out on closing parade.

Coming in activity: Making cardboard goggles and crepe paper scarves.

Equipment: Cardboard, scissors, crepe paper, wool or hat elastic.

Give each Joey Scout length of crepe paper to put around neck as a scarf. Cut around black cardboard goggle pattern and tie on wool or elastic. Template attached.

Introduction (set the scene). This week we have a special mission, we have to build a special flying machine. Fly it over our enemies; they are on their way here to invade us. We will then need to drop some bombs on them, so they we go back to where they came from and then we will have saved the whole of Australia.

So we are going to start with some training:

Game: Flying in formation

Equipment: Obstacles

Teams Line up with each Joey Scout touching the Joey Scout in front with their arms outstretched. On go, they run around the course without breaking formation.

Game: Radar Romp

Equipment: Use existing Obstacle course, Balloon per pair

Joey Scouts in pairs stand facing each other with blown balloon jammed between their tummies. On go they run around the obstacle course without losing their balloon.

Game: Bomber Training

Equipment: Plasticine, target (a ice cream container on a sheet of newspaper gives a bulls eye)

Each Joey Scout is given a plasticine bomb. Line the Joey Scouts up (for large Mobs form two lines). With arms outstretched as wings they run down the runway past the target with arms remaining outstretched drop their bomb at the target.

Plasticine recipe: Ingredients 2 1/2 cups flour, 1 cup salt, 1/4 cup vegetable oil, 1 cup water, food colouring, Mix dry ingredients. Add oil and stir. Add water a little at a time. Stir until it holds together well. Knead for 5 to 10 minutes. Add food colouring a little at a time. Knead until each colour is evenly worked. Store in airtight containers)

Game: Flying Blind (night flying)

Equipment: Blindfold per Joey Scout

Each Joey Scout is blindfolded. Leader calls out directions and paces and the Joey Scouts follow the directions.

Adventure Activity: Airplane Construction

Equipment: Cardboard boxes, tape, textas, crepe paper, parent helpers, extra cardboard like cereal boxes.

Place the Joey Scouts into equal groups. The groups make an airplane of their own design from the items provided, which will contain all members of the group at the same time. (Use your parent to assist the Groups of Joey Scouts). It is helpful if you have some handles cut in the boxes ready and some wing shapes already cut. Extra helpful items include lids, pieplates, doublesided tape and blutak, spilt pins.

Activity: Fly over mission

Equipment: Our plane from previous activity and our bombs and targets

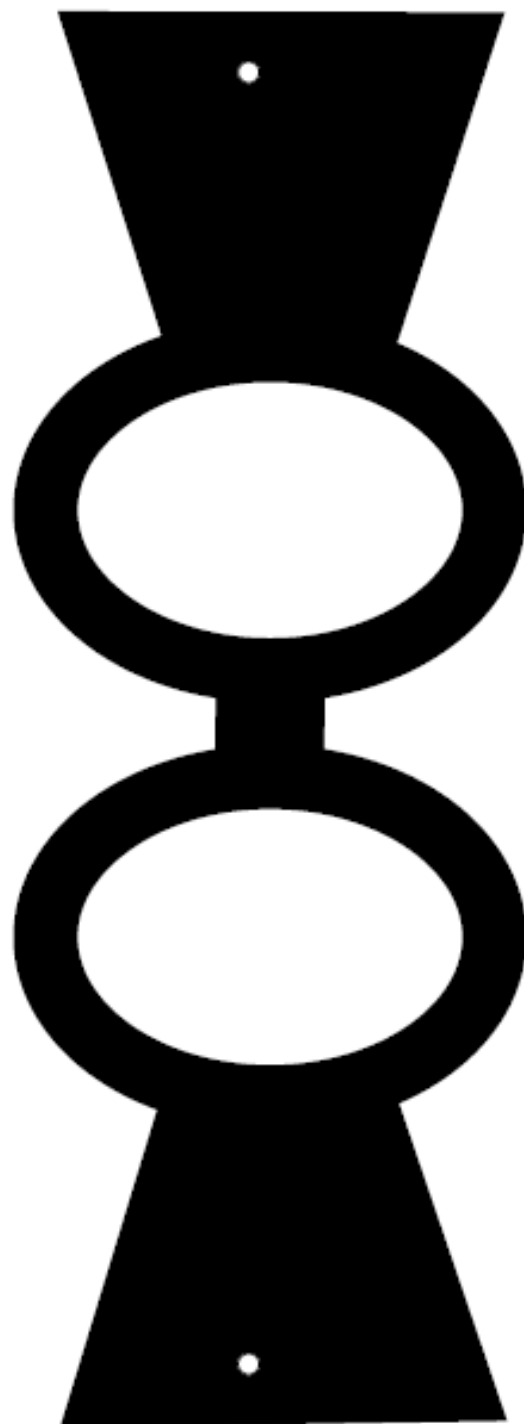
Each Group get into the airplanes they have made and fly past the targets dropping our bombs and returning home, parade past leaders and parents to show off the airplanes.
