Coming in activity: Bibs for dad

Birthdays:

Next week: Funday preparation – Norway

Notes: JS can give out there grass heads if dads there or take them home this week. Notes for: cub visit and district outing should go out this week. If anyone has any Norwegian item or heritage, we are visiting Norway next week and it would be great to share anything you have Norwegian.

Coming in activity: Bibs for dad

Equipment: Large garbage bags, scissors

Give the joeys a half of a large garbage bag to make a large bib for Dad. Have a sample one ready.

Game: Dress dad for work/day

Equipment: hats, sunglasses, ties, coat, hardhat, bike helmet, gumboots, or anything else you have lying around

Divide joeys and dads into 2-3 teams. Each team has a dad to dress and the rest are runners. They are running to a large box of items dad might need for the day. Make these as weird or funny as you like. Once dad is dressed the team sits in a straight line and dad must leave for work/day (cross the finish line). Don't forget to get a photo!

Game: 3 legged race

Equipment: ankle ties

A simple 3 legged race. Dad and joey tied together at the ankle race the length of the hall or relay.

Activity: Eat a jaffa/cool mint

Equipment: bowl, icing sugar, jaffa/cool mint

Divide into 3 teams. Each has a bowl of icing sugar with a jaffa or cool mint (harder to find). The dads must retrieve it. He is not allowed to use his hands, the mouth is the preferred collection tool. Let the joeys have a turn too.

Activity: Spaghetti/Baked Bean Feed

Equipment: bibs, spaghetti/baked beans, bowl, spoons

Those bibs may come in handy. All dads have to do is eat 3 spoonfuls of spaghetti/baked beans, unfortunately the joeys are holding the spoons. Joeys stand behind their dads and slip their arms under dad's to pretend that it's dad's arms and hands. Sit the dads at a table facing each other, so the joeys get to see what it looks like. (another photo chance)

Game: Donut on a string

Equipment: string, donuts or you can core an apple and cut into slices that are donut shaped.

An easy eating competition. Put all the strings the same length (hanging from the roof), so joeys can reach easily and dads have to bend down. Remember no hands.

Game: Poisonball (traffic safety)

Equipment: a couple of balls

Dad has to get their joey safely across the road (ie from one end of the hall to the other). They must be on the lookout for traffic (the balls). The ball throwers can be helpers or nominate some pairs to start off throwing. Play twice to give the throwers a turn at getting their joey safely across the road.
